4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- (a) The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+5 for the sanctioned D.Ed. course and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulations 2005.

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- (b) The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLTET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- (c) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- (d) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- (e) That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
- (f) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
- (g) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (h) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
- (i) The institutions intending to run the teachers training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject regarding their shift to permanent building.

5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993. The NCTE Hqrs. May also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.

6. It is mandatory for the institutions to complete 180 teaching days as such the concerned university/board should ensure the recognition granted as per NCTE regulations and if the recognition date did not match with the academic calendar then the recognition granted shall be effective from the ensuing academic session.



Revised Order

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE, VILLAGE- BHICHOLI MARDANA, INDORE MADHYA PRADESH by affidavit dt. 10.01.2015 has consented to come under new Regulations and sought for a basic unit of 100 (one hundred) students with two sections of 50 (fifty) each in B.P.Ed. Course, which require additional facilities

3. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have a basic unit of 100 (one hundred) students with two sections of 50 (fifty) each in B.P.Ed. Course, subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- II. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- III. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- IV. In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institutions shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Western Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

4. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in accordance with the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Western Regional Committee (NCTE) hereby issues the revised recognition order to VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE, VILLAGE- BHICHOLI MARDANA, INDORE MADHYA PRADESH for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (one basic unit with two sections of 50 (fifty) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body; the State Government etc, as applicable.
